

School Frequently Asked Questions
Drop Off and Pick Up



May I bring my family dog with me when I drop off or pick up my child?

Although your dogs and other pets are truly members of your family, they may not be brought on campus at drop off or pick up time. This is both for the safety of all children, and to comply with School Board policy. Thank you for your understanding with this.

What time does school begin for my student tomorrow?

TK/Kindergarten, Grades 1, 2, and 3:
School begins at 8:25am

Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8: School begins at 8:10am

What time can I drop my child off in the morning before school?

You may drop your child off as early as 7:50am. There will not be supervision before that time.

Since the first day of school is a Wednesday, is it an early dismissal day?

No, Wednesday, August 23rd is a regular dismissal day.

What time is dismissal for my student tomorrow?

Grades TK and Kindergarten dismissal is at 1:00pm

Grades 1, 2, and 3 dismissal is at 2:35pm

Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 dismissal is at 2:40pm

How does the drop off in the morning work?

Drop off in the morning has not changed. You may drop off your student as early as 7:50am. Parents may park their cars in either of the two semi-circular parking lots and walk in with their child, or may park their cars in the large rectangular parking lot between the junior high and the highway and walk in with their child, or parents may drop their child in either of the semi-circular drive ways where Dr. Bluestein and Mr. Turner are often greeting folks. The large rectangular parking lot has newly painted parking spaces.

How does dismissal pick up work?

Kindergarten families should arrive early enough to park their cars and walk in the kindergarten pick up area to receive their child. The kindergarten teachers will not release a child if the parent or guardian is not present, nor will they release a child to a parent in the parking lot waving or honking for their child. Thank you for your understanding; the safety and security of your student is our primary concern.

Grades 1 to 8 families will be able to pick up their children in the front of the school. Parents or guardians will have to park in one of the three parking lots and walk in to meet their child in the front of the school. With your permission, your child may also use the designated cross walks and proceed to your car, with your permission, although this is not the recommended procedure.

NEW: No vehicles will be allowed in the two semi-circular roads at dismissal time. In the past, many vehicles park on those two roads, and then other vehicles try to pass the parked cars, which makes for a dangerous situation. This is a new procedure, and it will take a some time to get used to, but please know this is done for the safety of our children. Dr. Bluestein has seen some near misses last year, and although this presents a bit of an inconvenience for some folks, it is far more safer for the children. The parking lots and cross walks will also be staffed with additional adult supervision during the dismissal hours.
