### ◆ Great California ShakeOut - October 19

Our annual Great California ShakeOut drill will take place this Wednesday, October 19th at approximately 10:30am (many schools will be doing this drill on October 20th, but Mesa will be doing it on October 19th to avoid scheduling conflicts).

This standard drill and evacuation uses simple steps to inform all teachers and students how to perform Drop, Cover, and Hold On – a quake-safe action designed to protect lives and prevent injuries from falling furniture and flying objects that can become projectiles during ground shaking. Teachers and students will then evacuate the building according to our school disaster plan. I will be spending extra time on Monday and Tuesday this week in our lower elementary grade classrooms to talk about this prior to the drill.
