Hello Mesa Families,

We have a busy and exciting week in store, culminating on Friday with our much anticipated Mesa Carnival. I am looking forward to seeing everyone at the Carnival in support of our school.

Please carefully look at all the upcoming dates in the left column on this page so you don't miss any of the events this week.

On Wednesday, we will have a 12:30pm dismissal so the teachers can participate in professional development (PD). This is some of the valuable work in PD the teachers will be doing on Wednesday: (1) teachers from each grade-level will travel to the County Office in Camarillo to start the very important process of selecting textbooks for the 20178-2018 school year in the area of English language Arts... this is a nearly year-long process, led by Superintendent Turner; (2) teachers in grades K and 2 will be participating in the follow-up to their Reading Results training, which started earlier this year; and (3) we will continue to look at state testing data, which is an important factor (but not the only factor) in informing our instructional planning/practice.

Dear Mesa School Community,

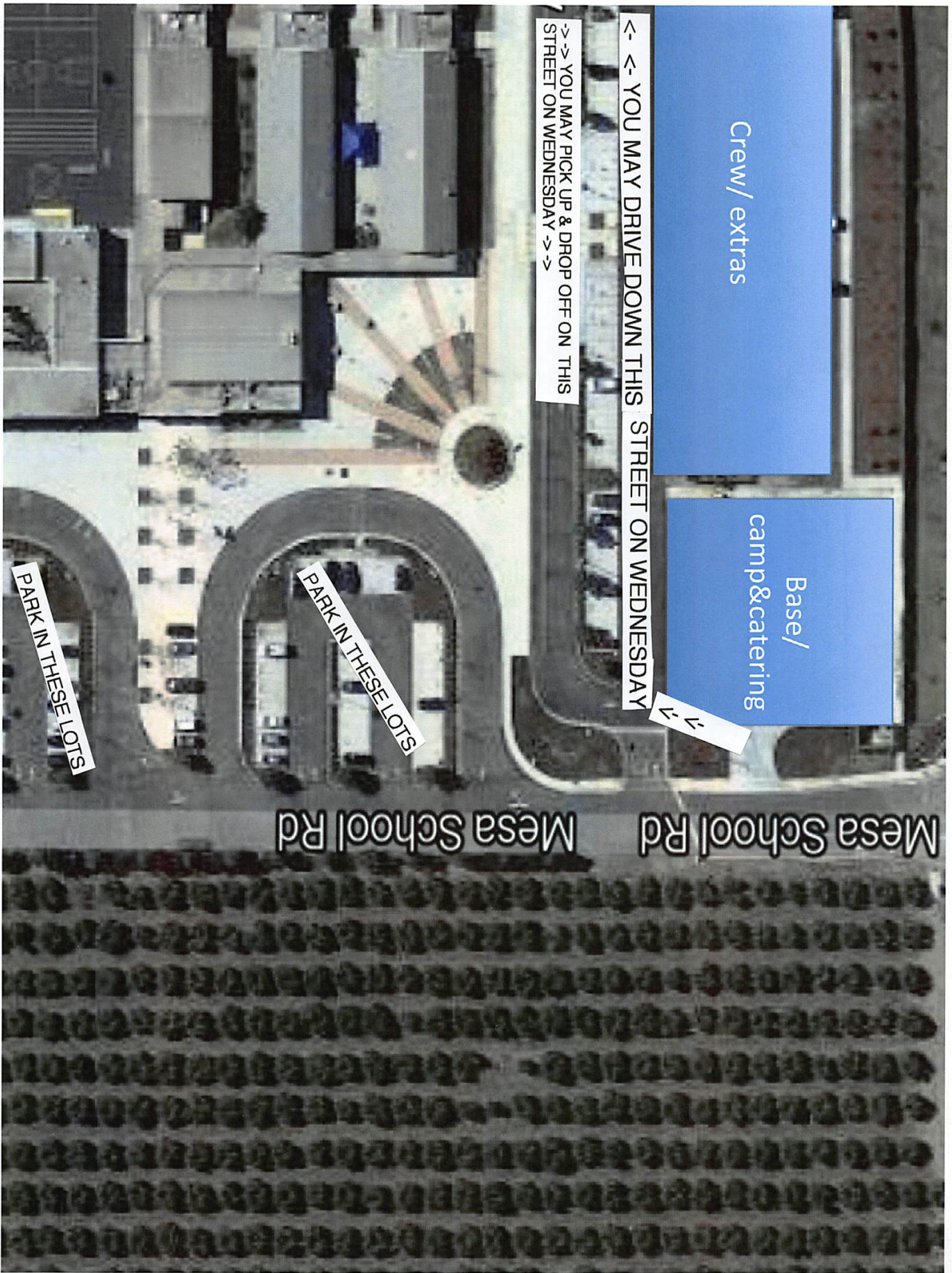
On **Tuesday and Wednesday, October 25 and 26, 2016**, Mesa Union School District will be leasing the big parking lot between the school and the highway to Disney Studios for a film shoot. Disney will be using the area for parking, logistics, and catering. They'll start work quite early in the morning and finish after dark both days. The compensation received by Disney will be used to enrich the instructional program at Mesa. It is exciting that we are establishing this continuing partnership, for the mutual benefit of the students and the entire Mesa community.

We have established specific parking and traffic flow standards for the studio people while present in the campus parking lot. We are hopeful that this will better support the Mesa School community, particularly at drop-off and pick-up times. We have arranged for most Mesa School employees to not park in the two u-shaped parking lots, thereby freeing up several car spaces that parents can utilize. You may utilize the two usual u-circle drive ways for pick up and drop off, and **on Wednesday** you may also drive through the big parking lot that Disney is using so you can use the long straight street where the school buses usually park. We plan to get the bus-riding students and the school buses off to any early start at the end of the day, and thereby free up that street for parent use. Please see attached map.

The studios are filming their last episode this week, so this should be the last of the filming for the foreseeable future. Thank you for your patience and understanding during the filming days this month. As always, if you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me.

Information:

California Education Code 64001(a) requires districts receiving state, federal and other applicable funding through the Consolidated Application (ConApp) process ensure that schools prepare a Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). The SPSA is a blueprint to improve the academic performance of all students to the level of the targeted performance goals.

Pursuant to California Education Code 52852, every school shall establish a School Site Council (SSC) as the decision-making council for all programs funded through the ConApp. Further, the SSC is responsible for developing, revising and adopting the SPSA, as well as ensuring that a school meets all federal parental involvement mandates, and the proposed expenditure of all categorical funds.

The functions, roles, and responsibilities of the SSC and ELAC are outlined on the slides presentation the Mesa School website.
