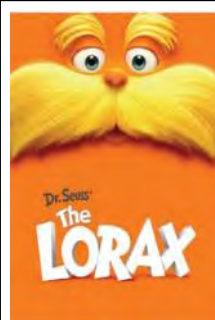

We will be celebrating Read Across America next week! Below are dress up days and special events that will be happening on campus for our students. Each dress up day next week, we will be honoring a famous Dr. Seuss book. We hope your kids will be able to participate! Happy Reading!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

Monday, February 27:

Book Theme: Oh, The Places You'll Go! (wear a favorite college shirt or sweatshirt)

The theme of this book is to "keep going" no matter what life throws at you so that you can accomplish your dreams. We want students to set goals and dream about their future. To honor this book we want our students to wear a college shirt or sweatshirt.

Tuesday, February 28:

Book Theme: Green Eggs and Ham (wear green)

In this book, it's all about adventure and exploration-not that the words of the story would indicate that at all. In fact, there are only 50 words in this story!! Dr. Seuss wrote the story to teach children about the wonders of trying things one hasn't tried before. You might end up liking it!! Wednesday March 1:

Dear Parents,

I would like to introduce parents to the 2017-2018 academic calendar for Mesa Union School District. As before, families will still enjoy a traditional August start time and June end time, a week of vacation during the Thanksgiving holiday and two weeks of vacation during winter and spring break. The District, with the support of the Board of Trustees and Teacher's Association, will implement a new Wednesday early release schedule for next year. Beginning in the fall of 2017, Wednesday dismissal time for K-3 students will be at 1:00 p.m. and dismissal time for 4-8 students will be at 1:05 p.m. The early release days will allow staff valuable time for professional development and collaboration as Mesa Union implements new state standards, curriculum, and an ever-evolving state assessment model. The new schedule will also create a daily common drop-off time in the mornings (7:50 a.m.) and pick-up time, thereby lessening the burden on parents while increasing instructional minutes at every grade level. New dismissal times, with the exception of Wednesdays, for K-3 students will be at 2:35 p.m. and dismissal times for 4-8 students will be at 2:40 p.m. Additional information can be found on the attached Mesa Union Academic Calendar.

In an effort to support parents with these changes, I will host a meeting on Wednesday, March 1, at 6:00 p.m. in the multi-purpose room. I will also be available to respond to questions about the new academic calendar on Tuesday, March 14, at the monthly Superintendent/Principal Breakfast, which is held in the cafeteria, hosted by the Parent Faculty Organization at 8:30 a.m.

As always, thank you for supporting Mesa Union School District and its students.

Estimados Padres,

Les quiero presentar a los padres el calendario académico 2017-2018 para el Distrito de la Escuela Mesa Union. Como antes, las familias seguirán disfrutando de un comienzo tradicional en agosto y fin de año en junio, una semana de vacaciones durante las fiestas de Acción de Gracias y dos semanas de vacaciones durante las vacaciones de invierno y primavera. El Distrito, con el apoyo del Consejo de Administración Escolar de Mesa Union y la Asociación de Maestros, implementará un nuevo horario los miércoles de salida temprana del año próximo. Comenzando en el otoño del 2017, la salida temprana de miércoles para los estudiantes de K-3 será a la 1:00 p.m. y salida para los estudiantes de 4-8 será a la 1:05 p.m. Los días de salida temprana permitirán al personal tiempo valioso para el desarrollo profesional y la colaboración, ya que Mesa Union implementa nuevos estándares estatales, currículo y un modelo de evaluación del estado en constante evolución. El nuevo horario también creará un horario diario de que puede dejar a sus hijo por las mañanas (7:50 a.m.) y hora de recoger, lo que disminuirá la carga sobre los padres mientras aumenta los minutos de instrucción en cada nivel de grado. Los nuevos horarios de despedida excluyendo los miércoles para los estudiantes de K-3 será a las 2:35 p.m. y despedida para los estudiantes de 4-8 será a las 2:40 p.m. Se puede encontrar información adicional en el Calendario Académico de Mesa Union que esta adjunto.

En un esfuerzo por apoyar a los padres con estos cambios, voy a organizar una junta el miércoles, 1 de marzo, a las 6:00 p.m. en el salón de multiusos. También estaré disponible para responder a las preguntas sobre el nuevo calendario académico el martes, 14 de marzo en el Desayuno mensual con el Superintendente/Director, que se lleva a cabo en la cafetería, organizado por la Organización de la Facultad de Padres a las 8:30 a.m.
