Some have *asynchronous development*: profound strengths mixed with neuro-typical, or delayed abilities creating a confusing profile. SENG groups offer parents an opportunity to share ideas, strategies and support in a relaxed setting, guided by SENG-trained facilitators. We emphasize positive parenting, avoiding power struggles, developing life skills, and enhancing relationships.
