Principal's Message

Hello Mesa Tiger Families:

Welcome back from Spring Break, and thank you for sending the school postcards of your travels near and far. So far, we have received postcards from Las Vegas, Portland, Napa Wine County, Tule Spring Fossil Beds National Monument (in Nevada), and Joshua Tree National Park. Keep those cards coming, and check out the map with all the postcards in the main office!



April and the rest of the school year is quite busy and the time will certainly fly by fast. In next week's Mesa Matters, I will be having a special page about "Everything CAASPP" talking about the State testing in grades 3 to 8, including the schedules, strategies, absences during testing, and more.

On Wednesday morning, we will be having a school-wide Earthquake drill where students will practice "duck, cover, and hold" and then proceed to the grass field assembly area away from buildings and other structures. I hope everyone is the Mesa Union community was not adversely affected by last week's Earthquake off of Santa Cruz Island (one of the Channel Islands that we can see from Mesa on a clear day).



On Wednesday, April 25th, we will be having the Ventura County Sheriff's department out to train staff on sheltering in place (we used to call this a "lock down"). After this training, we will practice a shelter in place drill the following day, on April 26th.

This week, all classes will be focusing on activities to promote tolerance and anti-bullying. We will be having different activities every day, starting today with a Community Circle discussion. The students are familiar with Community Circles, as we have been doing them at Mesa for the past two years. I will be sending you a separate letter regarding the week's activities in this area via your student's backpack tomorrow.



Congratulations 7/8th Grade Girls Basketball Camarillo Independent Sports League Champions. The girls won the championship the week before break. The 7/8th Grade Boys Basketball team made it to semi-final playoffs.
