### SCHOOL SUPERVISION

The safety of your child at school begins with adult supervision. Supervision starts for children at 7:50 and ends 15 minutes after their school day is complete.



Students may arrive at school no earlier than 7:50 and be picked up no later than 15 minutes after their day ends. This also includes early dismissal days. If a student gets out at 1:05, they cannot loiter around campus until a sporting or evening school event, as there is no supervision. Students will need to be picked up and brought back to school when the event begins.

**Students that are not picked up on time, will have to wait either inside the office or the courtyard area directly outside the office. Students are NOT allowed to wait in the front of the school or play on the playground or blacktop.**

It is the responsibility of the family to arrange transportation that gets children to and from school when appropriate supervision is present.

### SUPERVISIÓN DESPUÉS DE LA ESCUELA

La seguridad de su hijo comienza con la supervisión de un adulto. La supervisión para los niños comienza a las 7:50 y termina 15 minutos después de que el día escolar esté completo.



Los estudiantes pueden llegar a la escuela no más temprano de las 7:50 y ser recogidos no más de 15 minutos después de que terminen su día. Estoy también incluye los días de despido temprano. ## NATIONAL FARM to SCHOOL MONTH

October is National Farm to School Month, a time to celebrate the connections happening all over the country between children and local food. 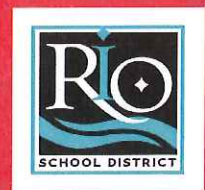
