### AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION

The safety of your child at school begins with adult supervision. Supervision starts for children at 7:50 and ends 15 minutes after their school day is complete.



Students may arrive at school no earlier than 7:50 and be picked up no later than 15 minutes after their day ends. This also includes early dismissal days. If a student gets out at 1:05, they cannot loiter around campus until a sporting or evening school event, as there is no supervision. Students will need to be picked up and brought back to school when the event begins.

**Students that are not picked up on time, will have to wait either inside the office or the courtyard area directly outside the office. Students are NOT allowed to wait in the front of the school or play on the playground or blacktop.**

It is the responsibility of the family to arrange transportation that gets children to and from school when appropriate supervision is present.

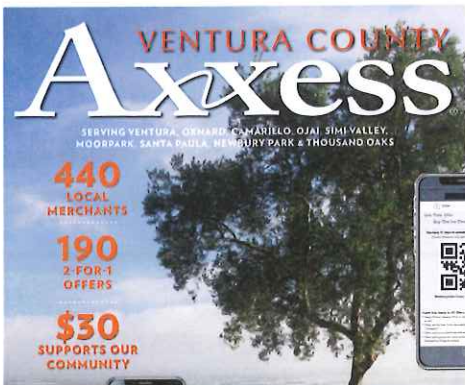

During the month of October we will be administering the CogAT.

## What is the CogAT?

The CogAT is a cognitive abilities test that measures general, abstract reasoning ability. It measures students' abilities to apply their reasoning skills to verbal, quantitative, and non-verbal tasks. Sometimes people wonder if it is an IQ test. It is not. The CogAT measures specific areas of reasoning that have been found to be linked to school success.

## What are the results used for?

Teachers use CogAT scores to help students learn more effectively. The results from the CogAT are combined with additional data in order to understand the learning profile of a student. They are used to determine how to differentiate and modify curriculum. Students' learning needs are addressed in the classroom using high-impact differentiation strategies, and may also be addressed during site-based, targeted instructional time. **Our school district will also use the CogAT test results to help identify academically gifted students for the GATE program.**

## Who is assessed using the CogAT?

- **ALL THIRD** grade students are assessed using the CogAT
- **FOURTH & FIFTH** graders not previously assessed
- **SIXTH-SEVENTH-EIGHTH** grade students may be considered on a case by case basis

## ¿Qué es CogAT?

CogAT es una prueba de habilidades cognitivas que mide la capacidad de razonamiento general y abstracto. Mide la capacidad de los estudiantes para aplicar sus habilidades de razonamiento para las tareas verbales, cuantitativas y no verbales. A veces la gente se pregunta si se trata de una prueba de inteligencia. No lo es. La prueba de CogAT mide áreas específicas de razonamiento que se han encontrado vinculadas con el éxito escolar.

## ¿Para qué se utilizan los resultados?

Los maestros usan los resultados de CogAT para ayudar a los estudiantes a aprender más efectivamente. Los resultados de CogAT se combinan con los datos adicionales con el fin de entender el perfil de aprendizaje de un estudiante. Se utilizan para determinar cómo diferenciar y modificar planes de estudio. Necesidades de aprendizaje de los estudiantes se abordan en el aula utilizando estrategias de diferenciación de alto impacto, y también se pueden abordar durante el tiempo de instrucción específica basado en el sitio. **Nuestro distrito escolar también utilizará los resultados de la prueba CogAT para ayudar a identificar a los estudiantes dotados académicamente para el programa de GATE.**

## ¿Quien es evaluado utilizando CogAT?

- **TODOS** los estudiantes de **TERCER** grado son evaluados usando CoGAT
- Estudiantes de **CUARTO- QUINTO** grado que no han sido evaluados previamente
- Estudiantes de **SEXTO - SÉPTIMO - OCTAVO** grado pueden ser considerados a base de caso por caso
