School Message

Hello Mesa Families,

We wanted to take a moment to address the events that transpired this week at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas. When senseless tragedies like this one take place, it is natural to experience a range of feelings. All of us who work with children or have children of our own cannot help but grieve the immense loss of life and suffering experienced by that community.

We know that it can be overwhelming to help your children through these times so we are providing "Tips on Responding to School Shootings" from the Ventura County Office of Education that you can access at: bit.ly/resources522

The safety and well being of our students and community continue to be our top priority. Mesa Union School District has a variety of safety measures in place to ensure our campus is as safe as possible including:

- Comprehensive safety plan to handle emergency situations which are reviewed and updated annually
- Regular drills, including lockdown drills
- Single point of entry during school hours
- All visitors must check in with front office
- Lock blocks on classroom doors
- Upgraded radio communication

We remain vigilant in our care and protection of our students and community. Please continue to support and care for one another as you have for so long.

SCHOOL SAFETY/EXPECTATION REMINDERS

As this year begins to wind down, it's important to keep in mind the following procedures and expectations:

SAFE AND SUPERVISED ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES:

The safety of your child at school begins with adult supervision. **Supervision starts for students at 7:45am and ends 15 minutes after their school day is complete.** Students may arrive at school no earlier than 7:45.

ITEMS THAT SHOULD STAY AT HOME:

Please help school staff maintain a safe learning environment by ensuring that your child leaves items at home that could harm others or disrupt teaching and learning. These include but are not limited to:

- toy weapons
- laser pens, electronic games
- skateboards, scooters, skates, in-line shoe skates
- permanent marking pens (ie: Sharpies)
- toys (unless teacher permission is given)
- gum

Sabemos que puede ser abrumador ayudar a sus hijos en estos momentos, por lo que estamos proporcionando "Consejos para Responder a Tiroteos Escolares" de la Oficina de Educación del Condado de Ventura a los que usted puede acceder:

La seguridad y el bienestar de nuestros estudiantes y la comunidad siguen siendo nuestra principal prioridad. El Distrito Escolar de Mesa Union tiene una variedad de medidas de seguridad para asegurar que nuestros planteles sean lo más seguros posible, que incluyen:

- Regular drills, including lockdown drills
- Simulacros regulares, incluyendo simulacros de encierro
- Punto de entrada única durante el horario escolar
- Todos los visitantes deben registrarse con la oficina
- Bloques de cerraduras en las puertas de los salones
- Comunicación actualizada de radio

Permanecemos vigilantes en nuestro cuidado y protección de nuestros estudiantes y comunidad. Por favor, continúe apoyando y cuidando de unos a otros como lo han hecho durante tanto tiempo.

RECORDATORIOS/EXPECTATIVAS DE SEGURIDAD ESCOLAR

Por favor, ayude al personal de la escuela a mantener un ambiente de aprendizaje seguro, asegurándose de que su hijo deje artículos en casa que podrían dañar a otros o interrumpir la enseñanza y el aprendizaje. Estos incluyen, entre otros:

- armas de juguete
- juegos electrónicos
- plumas de láser
- patinetas, scooters, patines
- marcadores permanentes (ej: Sharpies)
- juguetes (a menos que el maestro de permiso)
- chicle
