On Wednesday, June 8, the MERITO Foundation will honor 7th grader, **Sophia Turner** and 8th graders, **Jayden Bryant** and **Dreena Ogawa** as finalists in their "Tales of Exploration" competition. Mesa Union seventh and eighth grade students independently investigated local places and developed an impactful story of their place using

National Geographic's *GeoInquiry* process. They documented their story through the use of photography or graphics. Students developed a "Call to Action" to inspire others to conserve some aspect of their place, such as endemic species, water, or pollution reduction.

Both National Geographic and the MERITO Foundation, a Ventura-based environmental education non-profit organization, aim to educate children through outdoor field experiences that connect them with the Earth and encourage them to protect our natural resources. Our students will be presenting to local professionals and their peers during school next week. Families are welcome to attend our evening celebration at 5:30 in the cafeteria on Tuesday June 7. Congratulations to all our students that submitted projects! We're so proud of your hard work and commitment to educate others.



